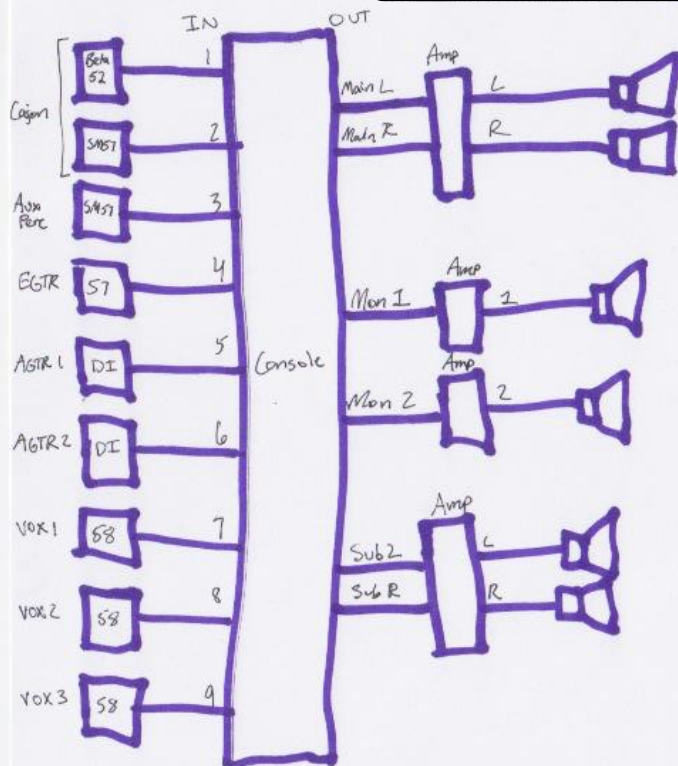

### Curb Cafe Summary

The set I had originally planned for included a full band, however, on the night of the show, only the front man and a harmony vocalist showed up. The frontman played an acoustic guitar for several songs, and a ukulele as well. The show started right on time, and pretty much went off without a hitch. During the first minute or two of the set, I was trying to dial in the reverb, so there are parts where it was very wet, as well as very dry (2:30). The harmony vocal was very quiet throughout the set, so trying to find a happy medium of melody to harmony was rather interesting, as I attempted to raise the volume of the harmony vocalist without feeding back into his monitor. At 5:52, you will notice that I was late in removing the reverb from the vocal as he spoke to the crowd, but promptly removed it around 5:53. I also eq'd the guitar a little bright in this section as well. Once I got the right wet/dry

ratio on the reverb, I was quite pleased with it. At 7:25, I made sure to engage the compressor on the vocal, as the vocal gets very hot during the chorus.

Overall, I was very impressed with the artist, and was very pleased at the performance as a whole.
